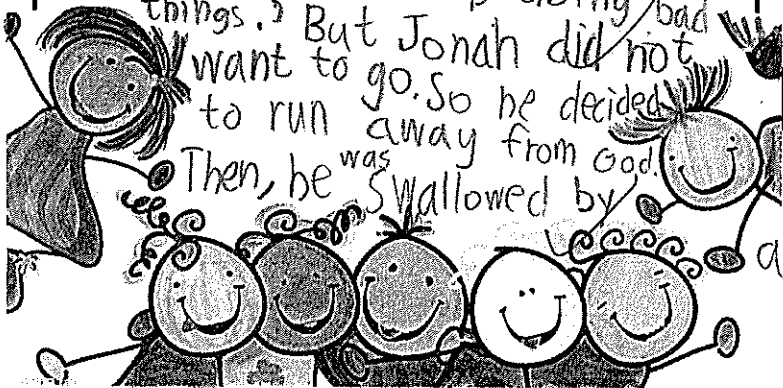

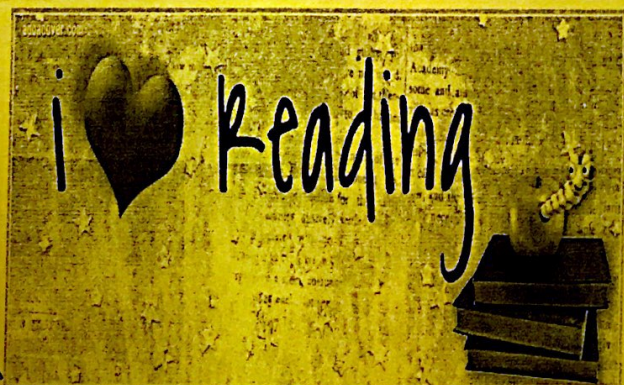

Shenzhen landslide was caused by illegal dumping of earth. It carries a strong message to society that the citizens should obey the laws.

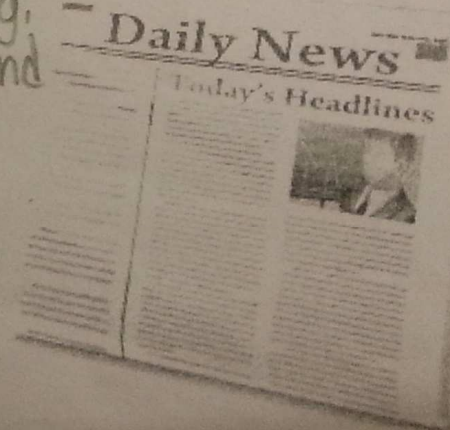
